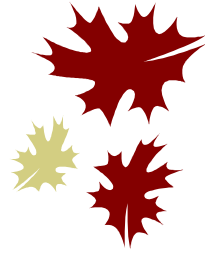
WALKING PROGRAM November 2nd - April 1st 3:30 PM - 7:30 PM

Community Service Hours

This is just a reminder to parents and students that community service hours **MUST** be **PRE-APPROVED** by the principal **BEFORE** a student can count community service hours for their senior project. Failure to get pre-approval could result in hours not being accepted for your project.

Adults: Adult volunteers that are organizing community events and looking for students to help with the event, should contact the principal at least 2 weeks in advance to get approval for students to help at the event and use hours for their community service project.

Students: Community Service/Job Shadow Paperwork must be submitted 30 days after completion of hours and forms must be properly filled out. All Signatures (including your parent, adult in charge of the event, and your principal) must be on the form. Also...your written report must be attached to your form when submitting to the office. Failure to provide all necessary information and paperwork will result in the form being returned to you.
